Weekly	VISUAL PLAYGROUND SAFETY INSPECTION – identify hazards such as broken parts, excessive or dangerous debris, vandalism etc. 1. Check area is reasonably flat with no trip hazards. 2. Visual check of play equipment, tables for hazards 3. Check for low branches and over hanging vegetation. 4. Carry out a litter pick and check for evidence of dog fouling. 5. Check for evidence of alcohol consumption. 6. Visual check on weeds, nettles etc.

Swing with flat seats – check seats, chains, and movement in frame and wet pour surface. 2. Rocking horse – check movement and wetpour surface 3. Spiro roundabout – check movement and wetpour surface 4. Scramble bike spring mobile - check movement and wet pour surface. 5. Faithful friend spring mobile - check movement and wetpour surface 6. Swing with 2 cradle seats - check seats, chains and movement in frame and wet pour surface. 7. Storm multiplay unit – check wooden surfaces, ropes, and wet pour surfaces. 	<p>Observations</p>
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8. Little Miss Muffet – check for signs of movement and general signs of wear and tear

9. timber picnic tables – check fixings and wood for hazards

10. Litter bin – movement/condition

11. Operators sign – firm fixed in ground.

12. Fence and hedge – condition.

13. Gate and ground entrance – ground erosion, gate closed.

14. Moss growth on wet pour playing surfaces.

Any other issues observed.
